

Sundance Meadow

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

PLEASE NOTE:

Cut all 14", 7-5/8", and 4-1/4" squares in half diagonally twice  for the number of triangles indicated in [].

Cut all 7-1/4" and 2-3/8" squares in half diagonally for the  number of triangles indicated in [].

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 10-1/4" x 90" multi-stripe borders (2 with black background, 2 with cream background)

Fabrics B and C - From each fabric:
Cut (1) 14" strip, subcut (2) 14" square  [8]
and (1) 7-5/8" square  [4]
Cut (2) 9-1/2" strips, subcut (6) 9-1/2" squares
and (4) 5" x 9-1/2" pieces

Fabric D - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 7-1/4" square  [2] and (5) 4-1/4" squares  [20]
Cut (5) 4-1/4" strips, subcut (45) 4-1/4" squares  [180]
Cut (4) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (1) 2" x 67-1/4" and (1) 2" x 64-1/4" borders
Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut 1 strip into (2) 1-1/2" x 21" strips

Fabrics E and H - From each fabric:
Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (9) 4-1/4" squares  [36]
Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (40) 3-1/2" squares
and (4) 2-3/8" squares  [8]

Fabric F - Cut (2) 4-1/4" strips, subcut (12) 4-1/4" squares  [48]

Fabric G - Cut (2) 4-1/4" strips, subcut (13) 4-1/4" squares  [52]


NOTE: Not all Fabrics C and D 7-5/8" and Fabrics D and I 7-1/4" triangles are used.

Fabric I - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 7-1/4" square  [2] and (5) 4-1/4" squares  [20]
Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (4) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (1) 2" x 67-1/4" and (1) 2" x 64-1/4" borders
Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut 1 strip into (2) 1-1/2" x 21" strips


Fabric J - Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 21" strips

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew a **Fabric D** 1-1/2" strip lengthwise between 2 **Fabric I** 1-1/2" strips. Subcut into (24) 1-1/2" wide Unit 1a (1-1/2" x 3-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make a **D-I-D** strip set and subcut 26 Unit 1b.




2. Stitch a **Fabric J** 1-1/2" x 21" strip lengthwise between 2 **Fabric D** 1-1/2" x 21" strips. Subcut into (12) 1-1/2" wide Unit 1c (1-1/2" x 3-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make an **I-J-I** 21" strip set and subcut 13 Unit 1d.




Stripe indicate orientation of directional print.

3. Sew a Unit 1c lengthwise between 2 Unit 1a. Make 12 Unit 2a (3-12" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 13 Unit 2b with Units 1b and 1d.




4. Arrange 2 **Fabric D** and 1 each **Fabrics H** and **G** 4-1/4" triangles as shown. Stitch triangles together. Make a total of 34 Unit 3a (3-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 3b-3f listed with fabrics indicated.






5. Sew **Fabrics E** and **H** 2-3/8" triangles together along their short edges as shown to make 4 each Units 4a and 4b (4-1/4" x 3" x 3" unfinished).




6. Arrange 2 **Fabric D** and 1 **Fabric F** 4-1/4" triangles, and 1 Unit 4b as shown. Stitch together. Make a total of 2 Unit 5a (3-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 each Units 5b-5d with fabrics and units indicated.




7. Arrange 4 **Fabric H** 3-1/2" squares, 1 Unit 2b, and 4 Unit 3a in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 **Block 1a** (9-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of **Blocks 1b-1d** listed with fabrics and units indicated.




8. Arrange 2 each **Fabrics E** and **H** 3-1/2" squares, and 1 each Units 2a, 3c, 3e, 5a, and 5b in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 **Block 2a** (9-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 **Block 2b** listed with fabrics and units indicated.



9. Sew **Fabrics B** and **C** 5" x 9-1/2" pieces together lengthwise. Make a total of 4 **Block 3** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



10. Sew **Fabrics B** and **C** 7-5/8" triangles together along their short edges as shown to make 1 each **Blocks 4a** and **4b** (10-1/4" x 7-1/4" x 7-1/4" unfinished).



11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of **Fabrics B** and **C** 9-1/2" squares, **Fabrics B** and **C** 14" triangles, **Fabrics D** and **I** 7-1/4" triangles, blocks, and borders.


12. Arrange **Fabrics B** and **C** 9-1/2" squares, **Fabrics B** and **C** 14" triangles, **Fabrics D** and **I** 7-1/4" triangles, and blocks in 11 diagonal rows. Stitch into diagonal rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (64-1/4" square unfinished).

13. Sew **Fabric D** 2" x 64-1/4" border to left side of quilt center and **Fabric I** 2" x 64-1/4" border to right side of quilt center.

14. Stitch **Fabric D** 2" x 67-1/4" border to top of quilt center and **Fabric I** 2" x 67-1/4" border to bottom of quilt center.



15. Center **Fabric A** 10-1/4" x 90" black background borders on top and left side of quilt center and **Fabric A** 10-1/4" x 90" cream background borders on bottom and right side of quilt center with narrow stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

16. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



17. The quilt measures approximately 86-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.


18. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!
